Over a lifetime of accompanying hymns, I have heard virtually every expression the human mind can devise to communicate that the body it guides did not know or did not like some hymn tune. "What's going on? Nobody knew any of the hymns this morning." "Who chose the (zth) hymn? I've never even heard it before. It doesn't seem to have any tune" "The (last) hymn today. If there's one hymn I really, *really*, dislike, that's it." .. and so on.

It was therefore refreshing, and somewhat unnerving, to have seven people tell me, individually, how much they had liked the closing hymn on Trinity XII, September 3. Most of them noted that it was Irish, and all of them made mention of the beauty of both the words and the music. Popular now in most Christian denominations, it appears in the various hymnals to one of two sets of words: "Be thou my vision, O Lord of my heart," or, "Lord of all hopefulness, Lord of all joy."

Success at last! Out of some 350 hymns I have accompanied at St. George's, two have been liked enough to evoke multiple compliments:

i) The Rev. John Dykes' truly glorious *Melita*, 512
(colloq. "The Navy Hymn")

and

ii) The Irish traditional tune, *Slane*, 363.

If we keep up the same pace, we shall reach a list of ten well-liked hymns by the year 2014.
